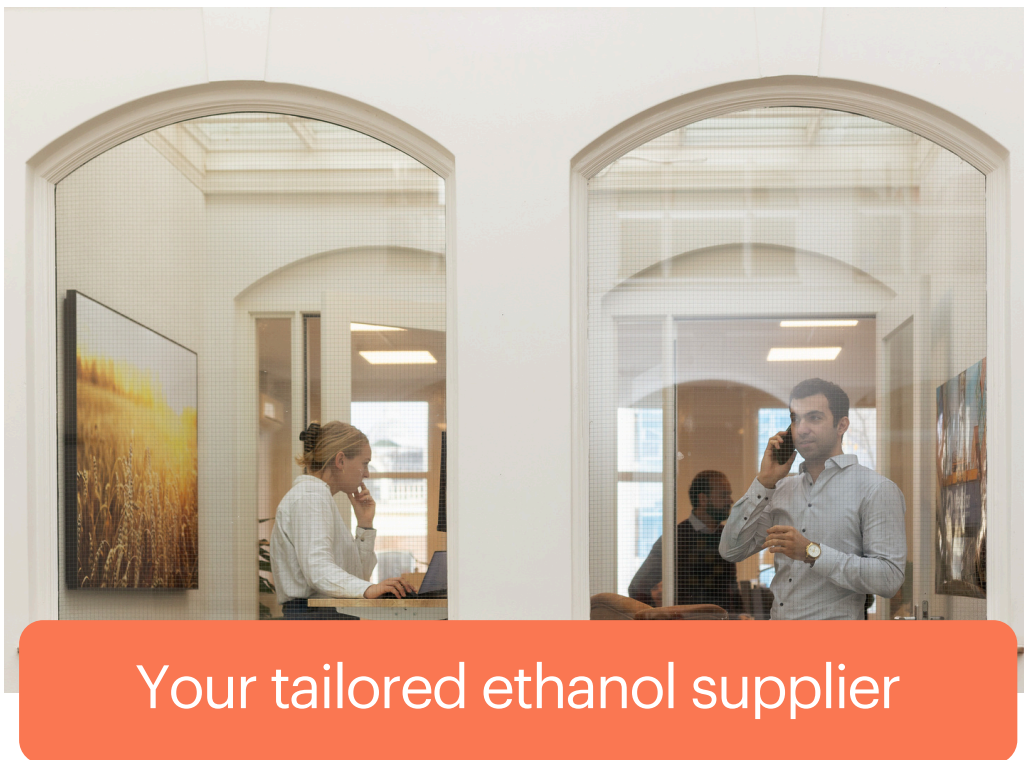

Food-Grade Ethanol

ABV at 20°C > 96%



Organic Alcohol

- Neutral odour, colourless
- Made exclusively from organic ingredients, such as sugar cane or grain alcohols, without the use of pesticides or synthetic fertilizers



Extra-Neutral Alcohol

- Neutral odour, colourless
- Made from raw materials such as sugarcane/molasses and grains like corn, rye, wheat, barley and rice



2G Ethanol

- Neutral odour, colourless
- Made from non-food biomass with significantly reduced carbon footprint and potential for net zero emissions

ABV at 20°C

All spirits can be certified organic

Whiskey

40% to 70%

- Odour and colour vary according to the type of whiskey
- Aged between 2 to 25 years
- We offer Scotch, Irish, Bourbon, Canadian and EU

Rum

40% to 95%

- Taste and colour vary with the ageing process
- Unaged or aged up to 32 years
- We offer White, Amber, Dark, Aged and Overproof rum

Brandy

38% to 77%

- Yellow-golden to red in colour with a sweet to mildly spicy taste
- Aged between 6 months to 15 years
- From France, Spain, non-EU, and more

Cachaça

48%

- Light and smooth taste with a spicy, mineral finish and colourless appearance
- Unaged or aged up to 5 years

- We offer London Dry, Plymouth, Old Tom, Genever, American, and Flavoured gin

Cider

4,5% to 14,9%

- Amber-brown colour with a sweet, acidic taste
- Aged from 3 months to 2 years

Wine Distillate

79%

- Neutral in colour, flavour varies by grape
- We also offer wine alcohol 96%

- Neutral taste and colour
- We also offer potato alcohol 96%

Cognac

40% to 60%

- Reddish-brown in colour with a sweet, spicy, fruity, and bitter flavour
- Aged from 2 to +14 years

Armagnac

52% to 60%

- Brighter flavour with earthy tones
- Aged from 1 to +10 years

Malt Wine

40% to 80%

- Dry taste with caramel tones
- Unaged or aged for up to 3 years

Baijiu

40% to 60%

- Floral, fruity, saucy, or spicy
- Made from sorghum or other premium grain alcohol like wheat, rice, and barley



Bulk Whiskey

ABV at 20°C

> 40%

Odour and colour

Both vary according to the type of whiskey, as it extracts characteristics from the wood in which it's aged

Scotch

Made from malt or grain, it has distinct smoky and peaty flavours

Irish

Made from malt, with flavours from light and floral to rich and complex

Bourbon

Made primarily from corn, it has a sweet and robust flavour profile

Canadian

Made from rye and a mix of grains and aged in oak barrels for a refined finish

Rye

Made from rye grain, it offers a spicier and fruitier profile

Corn

Made primarily from corn, it has a sweet and straightforward taste

White/Light

Aged longer than white rum, it has a richer colour and a more complex flavour, often with notes of vanilla, caramel, and spices

Dark/black

Deep, rich colour with a strong, full-bodied flavour profile

Aged/Premium

Ranges from lighter styles with oak influence to richer, aged tastes

Overproof

Higher alcohol content with an intense flavour

Raw Materials

All of our raw materials have at least 96% alcohol by volume at 20°C, are neutral in odour, and colourless. Read more to discover the applications of each product:

Sugar Cane Alcohol

Used in applications such as distilled spirits, preservatives, and solvents for colourants and flavours.



Sugar Beet Alcohol

Used in applications such as distilled spirits, vinegar, and solvents for colourants and flavours.

Potato Alcohol

Used in the production of vodka and other spirits, as well as in non-food applications within the pharmaceutical and cosmetics industries.



Grain Alcohol

Made from raw materials such as wheat, corn, rye, barley, and rice. It is used as a flavouring agent in cooking and spirits, as well as a key ingredient in the cosmetics industry for products like perfumes and fragrances.



Grape Alcohol

Also known as wine alcohol, it is used in a range of traditional drinks, including sherry and other fortified wines, pomace brandies such as grappa, and spirits such as gin and vodka.

Apple Alcohol

Crafted from the fermentation of apples, it is a key ingredient in traditional alcoholic beverages. In the non-food industry, it is used in cleaning solutions, solvents, and disinfectants.
